Tim has his USA Swimming Coach's certification and is looking forward to teaching with us this summer

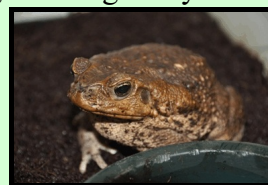
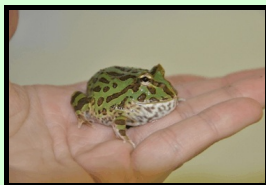
