A baby ferret is called a kit and has white fur when it is born.



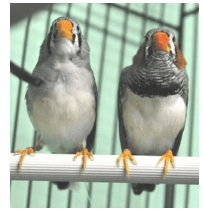
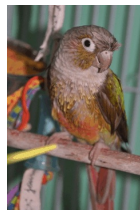
Lemurs are so Fun!
